Farm Suppers with Peter Harrison

The Farm Suppers are held **each Thursday** evening between 22nd April and 20th May at White House Farm **7.30pm arrival for a 8.00pm** start. The ticket price of £35.50 pp includes **refreshment upon arrival** and **a three course bespoke supper** created by **Peter Harrison** served by **candle light** in the farmhouse Dining Rooms. **Guests of Honour** each week include **Writers** staying at the farm and **local producers**. Max 36 guests for each Supper. Please book early. **Please BYO beer or wine for supper.**

Thursday 27th April: "Sahel". A three course supper taking inspiration from North African and Sub Saharan cuisine. **Dishes will include:** chermoula marinated cod, chickpea, red onion, parsley and sumac salad and Badingham goat tagine. **Guests of Honour** include **Alistair Carr** [Writing at Great Glemham Residency No 5] - Author of "The Nomad's Path: Travels in the Sahel".

Thursday 4th May: "Jamon". The supper will include various farmed and wild foods collected or harvested in East Suffolk. **Dishes will include:** skate and oyster salad, tempura wild garlic flowers; Suffolk yoghurt and honey ice cream, White House Farm garden rhubarb. **Guests of Honour** include **Aljos Farjon** [Writing at Great Glemham Residency No 6] - Honorary Resarch Associate at Kew a world expert on conifers and currently researching veteran oak trees in England over 400 years old.

Thursday 11th May: "Unearthed". The supper will use foods grown locally with some more exotic ingredients from the Alde Valley and further afield. Dishes will include: braised short ribs, spring vegetables; caramelised oranges, Sumatran peppercorn ice cream. Guests of Honour include Tessa Allingham [Writing at Great Glemham Residency No 7 and co-author of "Un-Earthed" - 'a book that celebrates producers, chefs and artisans along the Suffolk coast.']

Thursday 18th May: "Aloft". The final Farm Supper for Spring Festival 2017 supper will present foods from plants and trees in the Alde Valley together fresh seasonal produce from Glemham House gardens and the Suffolk Coast. **Dishes will include:** asparagus salad. Lemon tart, elderflower sorbet. **Guests of Honour** include **Jack Cooke** [Writing at Great Glemham Residency No 8] * Author of "The Tree Climber's Guide" [Harper Collins, 2016].
