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# Project Update

#### Overview



- 3.2 GW new nuclear power station, north of Sizewell B
- Replicates Hinkley Point C in Somerset, reducing risks and costs
- Enough low-carbon electricity to supply 6 million homes
- Avoids c. 9 million tonnes of carbon emissions each year, compared to a gas-fired power station
- Associated development including permanent:
  - Two village bypass
  - Sizewell link road
  - Yoxford roundabout / highway improvements
- Development Consent (DCO): 15 July 2022

### 2022-23 Main Site Early Works



- Habitat creation, archaeology, ecology, UXO and vegetation clearance
- Early site accesses and office accommodation
- Work will roll out to associated development sites in 2024



#### 2024



- DCO Commencement 15 January 24
- Deed of Obligation:
  - £250m package
  - £100m for the environment (including the Environmental Trust)
  - Resilience Funds for RSPB / National Trust / Leiston Abbey
  - £23m Community Fund
  - £22m for employment and skills
  - Working Groups and Community Forums launched
- Earthworks to start Q224 main development site

# Tourism

#### £12m Tourism Fund



- £1,000,000 released on Commencement
- £571,429 per annum up to 14th anniversary of Commencement
  - £500,000 to promotional and marketing activities; £71,429 monitoring
- Supported by a Tourism Programme Manager (ESC) and a Tourism Fund Marketing Manager (ESC)
- Measures to be set out in an Annual Tourism Fund Implementation Plan to be approved by the Tourism Working Group (DMO, Visit Suffolk, Suffolk & Essex Coast & Heaths National Landscape, ESC, SCC, SZC, NALEP)

#### **Annual Tourism Implementation Plan**



- Development of Tourism Strategies and Action Plans
- Marketing and promotion activities for East Suffolk and specific attractions and events within it;
- Supporting local projects including capital and revenue investment;
- Supporting existing tourist initiatives and activities run and/or operated by local stakeholders;
- Supporting initiatives focused on particularly sensitive attractions and/or locations within the Suffolk & Essex Coast & Heaths National Landscape
- Supporting initiatives that enhance, complement, or promote rights of way and cycleways;
- Developing monitoring and market research, including monitoring the visitor economy and visitor behaviour, undertaking future visitor surveys, and market research
- Provision of information on issues and/or perceived effects that may be of concern to potential visitors and that may deter potential visitors from visiting East Suffolk

# **Tourism Fund Principles**



- Money spent must:
  - Mitigate potential effects by supporting the maintenance, development, and enhancement of the visitor economy in East Suffolk
  - Promote a sustainable visitor economy
  - Demonstrate value for money
  - Relate to measures and activities that support existing and on-going tourism strategies for East Suffolk
  - Demonstrate a measurable economic benefit to the tourist economy in East Suffolk
  - Not conflict with / not duplicate / complement other mitigation secured elsewhere in the Deed
